# REGIONAL CABINET FOR YOUTH WORK (RCYW) APPLICATION

#### **Positions**

**Vice Moderator**: Must be a current high school sophomore. The Vice Moderator serves his or her junior year and then automatically becomes the Moderator his or her senior year. The Moderator presides over all CYF Executive Committee, Cabinet, and Commission meetings and attends the Regional Executive Committee meetings representing the CYF of the Region.

**Secretary**: Must be a current freshman, sophomore, or junior. The Secretary keeps minutes of all CYF Executive Committee and Cabinet meetings. The Secretary is responsible for editing the Regional CYF Newsletter.

**Youth Delegate:** Must be a current high school freshman, sophomore or junior. Serve as a general delegate to the RCYW.

**Adult Advisors:** One (1) adult serves as Regional Youth Advisor on a three (3) year term. Two (2) additional adult delegates will also provide guidance and supervision to the Cabinet, each serving a two (2) year term, elected in alternating years.

### **Qualifications for RCYW Applicants:**

Persons applying for Cabinet and Executive Committee positions should be active in their local CYF, attend regional camps and other regional CYF activities, show an interest in being part of the youth ministry of the Region, exhibit leadership qualities, be able to work together with others as a team, and have good references from their minister, local youth advisor, and other adults. Previous service on RCYW will be considered as well, but does not guarantee nomination. Anyone serving as a member of the General Youth Council of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)or on National Convocation will automatically be on the RCYW, but may not serve on the Executive Committee.

All members of the RCYW must have transportation. Travel is extensive, especially for the Executive Committee. Not all applicants for RCYW will be guaranteed an interview during the selection process.
