A Final Pastoral Letter from our Regional Minister



Dear Church:

On the day I wrote this letter, my initial Pension Fund Check was deposited into my checking account. I never thought I would be old enough for that experience.

It seems unreal that 14 years ago Jeannine and I were preparing to move from Georgia to North Carolina. Depending on which window I look through, that seems like a lifetime ago, or just yesterday. From both perspectives, I can genuinely say I am grateful for the opportunity to have served the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in North Carolina as your regional minister.

Over these fourteen years I have grown to love the Christian Church in North Carolina. I have not always agreed with decisions of some, but I have never doubted my love for you. There have been moments when you have disappointed me, and I have disappointed you. But I pray we have never doubted our love for each other. A few churches have closed, and we celebrate their years ministry—a ministry whose influence will never end. Some churches have chosen to leave. Their decisions have grieved us all. And, we give thanks for the new congregations that have been established. Our regional church is different than it was 14 years ago, just as I am different, but we the church are still seeking to be faithful in our response to God's calling.

The Executive Committee of the Regional Board has appointed Valerie Melvin, who has served as Associate Regional Minister

since 2007, as Acting Regional Minister for up to 90 days, while the Executive Committee continues the search for an Interim Regional Minister. Beth Burton-Williams, pastor of First Christian Church, Smithfield, has agreed to serve as chair of the search committee for the new Regional Minister. Members of the search committee and the process used will be announced in the near future. Please keep all our regional leaders in your prayers during this time of transition.

During the transition, our regional church has the full support of our General Minister and President and the College of Regional Ministers. Greg Alexander, Regional Minister for the Christian Church in Kentucky is representing both, serving as our Search Committee consultant.

The Retirement Dinner in early November is an evening I will always remember. It was a lovely night, with cherished memories shared by so many. Thank you!

The Legacy Fund gifts now total approximately \$5,000. Our sisters and brothers in The Community of the Disciples of Christ in the D. R. Congo, who live in and around the village of Bolenge, will be profoundly grateful for the improved healthcare your gifts will make possible.

In closing, I want to express deep gratitude for the commitment I have witnessed across our regional church to welcome all to the Lord's Table. It is only by the grace of God that any of us have a place at the Table. Disciples of North Carolina, the one thing I will always remember about you is your commitment to make room for all at the Table. That is, I believe, what makes us Church.
